SCI OVERVIEW

Founded in 1971 by C.J. McElroy, Safari Club International (SCI) soon evolved into a world-wide organization that promotes wildlife conservation and education, provides services for people in need, and functions as an advocate for hunters and hunting. Almost 53,000 members in 85 countries and over 188 chapters in 22 countries empower SCI's mission around the globe. In 2000, SCI was reorganized into two separate entities. The Safari Club International Foundation was formed as a non-profit charitable organization under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) Code and Safari Club International was formed as a non-profit social advocacy organization under 501(c)(3) of the IRS Code.
